


The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's new CSA (Compliance, Safety and Accountability) initiative places increased importance on fleets to meet or exceed the rules as outlined in FMCSA's Conspicuity Requirements for Commercial Vehicles. During roadside inspections, compliance to these requirements will be easy to check and therefore an area of emphasis by the CSA inspectors. Vehicles that lack conspicuity to minimum standards may be taken out of service and will result in at least three penalty points assessed to the fleet operator.
